# Wild Blessings Craft Shoppe

In every season you will discover wild blessings to add to your Nature Scrap Shoppe.

Organize them in labeled soup cans by categories so it's easy to find what you need when you start creating.

Always ask "What does this look like?" "What could I use this for?" "What else could it be?"

#### WOOD

Sticks, twigs, branches, sapling trunks, bark, grape tendrils, stumps, tree wedges from tree cuts, driftwood...

#### **EVERGREENS**

Pine, Cypress, Juniper, Firs, Spruce, Pine Cones Use boughs, and needles

#### **ROCKS**

Pebbles, weird shaped rocks, flat rocks, colorful rocks, heart shaped rocks, rocks to build with, rocks for stands, flower rocks, dragonfly rocks, Fruit of the Spirit rocks...

## **MOSS - LICHEN - FUNGI**

Reindeer moss, Pincushion moss, Lichen, Elephant ear, Reishi, Turkey Tail, Earth Stars

## **NUTS**

Chestnuts, Hickory nuts, Beech nuts, Black Walnuts, Buckeyes, Butternuts, Acorns (Red and White), Acorn Caps (all kinds), husks, nut shells

## **DRIED FLOWERS**

Pick flowers in the Summer at the height of their energy in due season, bundle and dry upside down

## WINTER LEAVES

Lambs Ear, Mullein, Rhododendron, Holly, Mountain Laurel,

## **GRASSES - SEDGES - RUSHES**

Pompous grass, Foxtail grass, Crabgrass, Bulrush, Cattail...

## **SEEDPODS**

All plants go to seed and all seeds are housed in unique and fascinating pods, collect them all. Cut long stems for Winter Bouquets

## **VEGETABLE PARTS**

Pumpkin stems, Garlic cores, Apple peels, egg shells...

## **SEEDS**

Each seed is unique and beautiful in and of itself. The life is in the seed

## ANIMAL RELATED

Feathers, snake skins, bones, antlers, bird nests

## **BERRIES**

Dried Summer Berries, Winter berries (Barberries, Rose Hips, Beautyberries, Hawthorn haws

# NON WILD STUFF

Jewels, beads, buttons, ribbons, decorative tiny birds, lady bugs, fabrics

## **MISCELLANEOUS**

Roots, shells....

## **SUPPLIES**

Sheers, scissors, wire cutters, wire, hemp, glue guns, glue sticks, glue, needle and thread, paint, organizational set up (soup cans to put things in)
