## God Is Creator

**Genesis 1:1** “In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth”

**Genesis 1:31** “and God saw everything that He had made, and behold, it was very good.”

**John 1:1-3** “In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him not even one thing came into being that has come into being.” Verse 14 “...and the Word became flesh and dwelt among us...”

**Revelations 4:11** “Worthy are You, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for You created all things and by Your will they existed and were created.”

**Colossians 1:16** “For by Him all things were created, both in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible...all things have been created through Him and for Him. He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together.”

**Isaiah 44:24** Thus says the Lord, your Redeemer, and the one who formed you from the womb, “I, the Lord, am the maker of all things, Stretching out the heavens by Myself and spreading out the earth all alone,

**Romans 1:20** For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse

**Isaiah 43:10,11** Before Me there was no God formed, and there will be none after Me. I, even I, am the Lord, and there is no savior besides Me.

**Hebrews 1:1-3** God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways, in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world. And He is the radiance of His glory and the exact representation of His nature, and upholds all things by the word of His power. When He had made purification of sins, He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high.

## God Is Truth

*1/3rd of the Bible is prophetic*

**Isaiah 40:8** “The grass withers and the flowers fall but the word of our God stands forever.”

**Psalms 119:89** “Forever, O Lord, your word is firmly fixed in the heavens.”

**Psalms 119:160** “The sum of Your word is truth.”

**Numbers 23:19** “God is not a man, that He should lie, nor a son of man, that He should repent; Has He said, and will He not do it? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?”

**2 Timothy 3:16** “All Scripture is inspired by God”

**2 Peter 1:16-21** “For we did not follow cleverly devised tales when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of His majesty. For when He received honor and glory from God the Father, such an utterance as this was made to Him by the Majestic Glory, “*This is My beloved Son with whom I am well-pleased*”— and we ourselves heard this utterance made from heaven when we were with Him on the holy mountain.”

So we have the prophetic word made more sure, to which you do well to pay attention as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star arises in your hearts. But know this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture is a matter of one’s own interpretation, for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God.”

**Isaiah 46:9-11** “Remember the former things long past, for I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is no one like Me, declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times things which have not been done, saying, ‘My purpose will be established, And I will accomplish all My good pleasure’; Truly I have spoken; truly I will bring it to pass. I have planned it, surely I will do it.”

## God Is Just

**Deuteronomy 10:17** “For the LORD your God is God of gods and Lord of lords, the great, the mighty, and the awesome God, who is not partial and takes no bribe.”

**Psalms 89:14** “Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne; steadfast love and faithfulness go before you.”

**Isaiah 9:7** “There will be no end to the increase of His government or of peace, on the throne of David and over His kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness from then on and forevermore. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will accomplish this.”

**Job 34:12** “It is unthinkable that God would do wrong, that the Almighty would pervert justice.”

**Isaiah 5:16**

“But the Lord of hosts is exalted in justice, and the Holy God shows himself holy in righteousness.”

## The Wrath of God

**John 3:36** “He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.”

**Romans 5:9** “Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him.

**Romans 2:5** “But because of your stubbornness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God.”

**Hebrews 10:31** “It is a terrifying thing to fall into the hands of the living God.”

**Colossians 3:5,6** “Therefore consider the members of your earthly body as dead to immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and greed, which amounts to idolatry. For it is because of these things that the wrath of God will come upon the sons of disobedience.”

**1 Thessalonians 1:9,10** “You turned to God from idols to serve a living and true God, and to wait for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead, that is Jesus, who rescues us from the wrath to come.”

## God is Love

**Ephesians 2:4-5** - “But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved”

**Romans 5:8** - “But God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.”

**1 John 4:9,10** “By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world so that we might live through Him. In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.”

**Psalms 86:15** “But You, O Lord, are a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abundant in lovingkindness and truth.”

## Good Works Can Not Save

**Isaiah 64:6** “All our righteous deeds are like filthy rags.”

**Ephesians 2:8,9** “For by grace you have been saved through faith. And that not of yourselves it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast. For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.”

**Titus 3:5-7** “He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit, whom He poured out upon us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that being justified by His grace we would be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. This is a trustworthy statement; and concerning these things I want you to speak confidently, so that those who have believed God will be careful to engage in good deeds.”

**Galatians 2:16** “A man is not justified by the works of the Law but through faith in Christ Jesus, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, so that we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the Law; since by the works of the Law no flesh will be justified.

**Romans 11:6** “But if it is by grace, it is no longer on the basis of works, otherwise grace is no longer grace.”

**Romans 3:21-27** “But now apart from the Law the righteousness of God has been manifested, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, even the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all those who believe; for there is no distinction; for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus; whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation in His blood through faith. This was to demonstrate His righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed; for the demonstration, I say, of His righteousness at the present time, so that He would be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus. Where then is boasting? It is excluded. By what kind of law? Of works? No, but by a law of faith. For we maintain that a man is justified by faith apart from works of the Law.”

# God's Remedy - Jesus The Way

**John 3:16** "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life."

**Romans 6:23** "For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

**Romans 5:6-9** "For while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. For one will hardly die for a righteous man; though perhaps for the good man someone would dare even to die. But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him."

**1 John 4:9,10** "By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world so that we might live through Him. In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins."

**1 John 5:20** "And we know that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding, so that we may know him who is true; and we are in him who is true, in his Son Jesus Christ. He is the true God and eternal life."

**Colossians 1:13,14** "For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins."

**Colossians 2:13,14** "When you were dead in your transgressions and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made you alive together with Him, having forgiven us all our transgressions, having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross."

**Colossians 1:20** "Through Jesus to reconcile all things to Himself, having made peace through the blood of His cross."

**John 19:30** "He said, *"It is finished!"* And He bowed His head and gave up His spirit."

*"It is finished" (Greek: tetelestai) were the final words of Jesus on the cross, signifying that His sacrificial mission to pay for humanity's sins was fully completed. It indicates that the debt of sin is paid in full, salvation is achieved, and no further works are needed.*

# Our Response

Believe - Receive - Repent - Jesus is Lord

**John 1:12** "But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name."

**Romans 10:9,10** "If you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation."

**Mark 1:15** "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel."

**John 11:25,26** "Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies."

Jesus answered them, “I showed you many good works from the Father; for which of them are you stoning Me?” The Jews answered Him, “For a good work we do not stone You, but for blasphemy; and because You, being a man, make Yourself out to be God.”

## Jesus is the Only Mediator

**John 14:6** Jesus said, “I am *the Way, the Truth and the Life*, no one comes to the Father except *through Me*.”

**1 Timothy 2:5-6** “For there is one God and *one mediator* between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself as a ransom for us all, the testimony given at the proper time.”

**Acts 4:12** “And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved.”

**1 John 2:1** “My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.”

**1 John 5:9-12** “And the testimony is this, that God has given us eternal life, and this life is *in His Son*. He who has the Son has the life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have the life.”

**1 Peter 1:3,4** “Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope *through* the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.”

**Titus 3:4-7** “But when the kindness of God our Savior and His love for mankind appeared, He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit, whom He poured out upon us richly *through* Jesus Christ our Savior, so that being justified by His grace we would be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.”

**Hebrews 7:25** “Therefore He is able also to save forever those who draw near to God *through* Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.”
